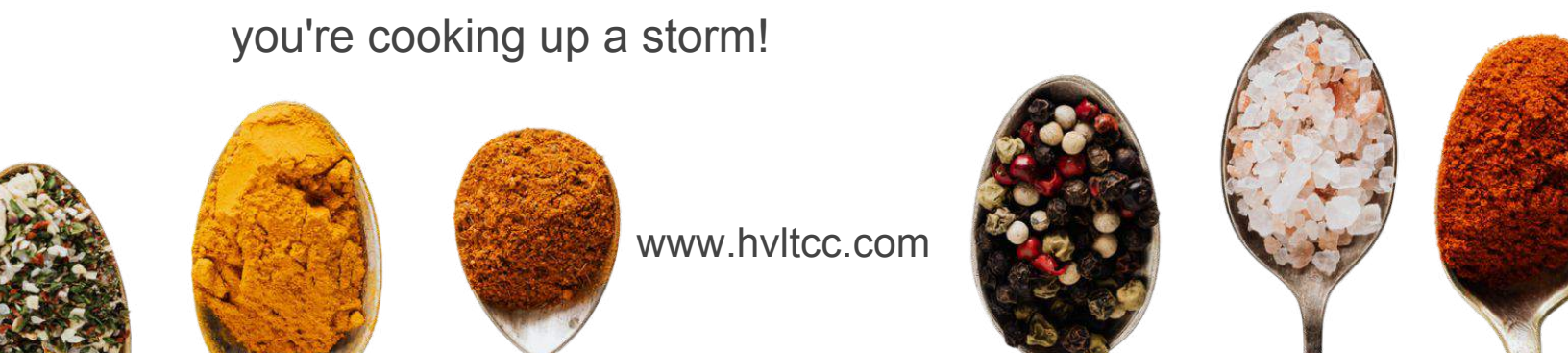
How to Cook Like a Pro: New Official Conversion Chart

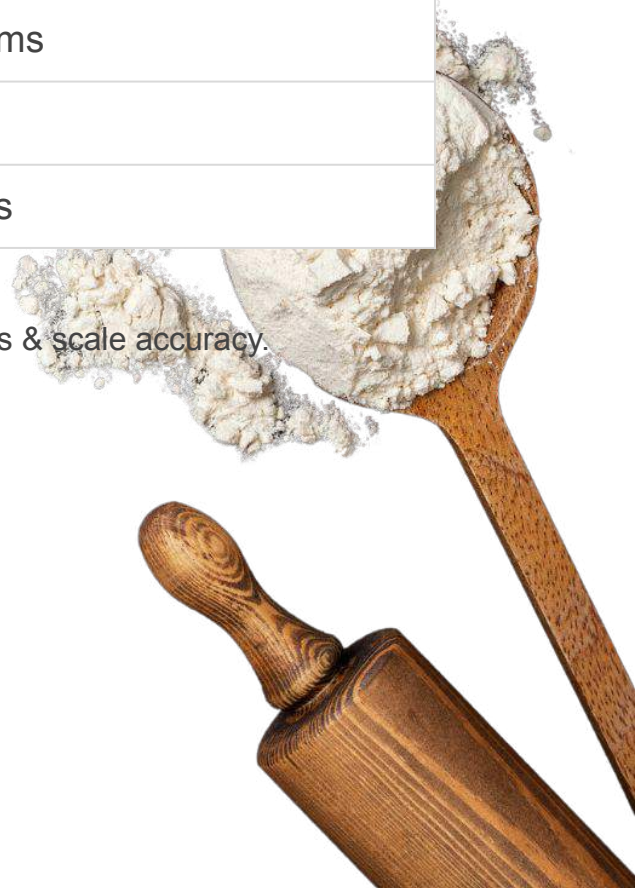
So go ahead and AirDrop this chart or print it out and keep it in your kitchen - it'll be a lifesaver next time you're cooking up a storm!
